Harvest time is upon us and we are in the process of "tucking in" the bees for winter, which involves harvesting excess honey & feeding them sugar syrup made with sugar & water, putting entrance blocks & mouse-guards on the hives and giving varroa treatment to keep them safe and warm during the coming months. Children are back to School but the farm will remain **open through winter including 10-4 on Sundays, Closed**

Mondays except when we take our annual family holiday with Jasmine when we will be **Closed Monday 25th October, Re- Open Tuesday 2nd November.**

We have some beautiful Section Honey from our Bees here on The Isle Of Sheppey. Section Honey is made by bees in a natural food-grade wax comb inside a frame, to give us honey just as Mother Nature intended. It has become a real delicacy these days as only happy, healthy bees will draw the comb out and cap it perfectly when they have filled it with honey containing pollen grains.

Cut a piece from the frame, bite into it and the honey will explode onto your taste buds, chew and eat for your health and delight! Each section weighs approximately

500 grams costs £12.99 but hurry as they sell out very quickly.
